Start Procedures

There will be no boat measuring before the race only the numbers will be checked at the raft marshal. The start will be from behind an automatic starting gate.

All classes start positions have been completed by random draw and you will find the draw positions on the website upon arrival. The draw positions are numbered from the left facing in the direction of the course. Boats will line up in a numerical order.

Launching on to the water will only be from the indicated rafts and this will be a controlled area, the officials will check each person's boat on to the water. The boat must be in an undamaged state. Warm up area for all races in that session is behind the automatic start system.

ALL BOATS RACING HAVE TO BE ON THE WATER WELL BEFORE THEIR START TIME. RAFT MARSHALLING WILL CLOSE 5 MINUTES BEFORE START TIME OF THE SESSION. BOATS HAVE TO PASS THE RAFT MARSHALLING, OTHERWISE THEY ARE CONSIDERED NOT TO START.

THE STARTER WILL NOT WAIT FOR LATE PADDLERS.

The starter will call the paddlers to the start line. Please ensure that paddlers approach their starting point as quickly as possible in order that the start may commence on time.

The starter commands will be clearly heard by all the competitors through loudspeakers placed along the automatic starting system.

All his commands will be in English and the start command will be READY - GO.

Please note rule 10.4 and the possibility of time penalties.

Finish

The timing and race results will be dealt with at the finish tower and access to this area will only be available to the Competition Committee and main event officials. Video finish equipment is installed and will be used where applicable. The finish line is only between two white buoys with red flags. The exact line will be on or slightly before the buoys line. An audible signal will identify the finish of each paddler.

After the finish, all competitors have to disembark at the same place where they enter before their race (see map).

Finish Area


Paddlers should clear the finish area as soon as possible and must not, under any circumstances, cross the finish line twice.. For others the disembarkation must be at the same point you entered the water using the lane between the pink buoys and the bank. A marshal will indicate when it is safe to pass across the course in front of the timing to not interfere with boats who are still on the course.

Boat Numbers

During the race, you must wear a number on your boat. The numbers will be given to you at the Master's Lounge. The numbers must be secured to the slot with a pin inserted through the hole in the slot and the number. The number must be returned immediately after the race at the raftmarshal place. If this rule is not followed, you will be given a fine of 10 EURO per number.

The number boards will be number coded per age group and numbers allocated in a format to make class identification possible where different classes are starting in the same start.

Boat repairs or assistance with boat problems will be provided by the boat providers/repair shop. Please consult the boat suppliers across from the athlete area.



Course Details

There will be a big map on the Notice Board in the Athlete area.

Maps of the course will also be found at the website, notice boards and in this document. There is a Jetty Disembarkation. The running distance of the portage is about 100 metres with a pontoon for disembarkment a beach embarkation.

The running distance of the portage is on a carpet, grass, and beach.

NO PORTAGE AFTER THE FIRST LAP IN LONG DISTANCE (first portage is after appr. 6,6 km)

Portage - Helper's access

Only a maximum of ONE helper per Master Athlete, will be allowed to feed paddlers and these must be in possession of a feeder zone bracelet. The helper bracelet for the feeding zone costs EUR 15 and can be bought at the Welcome Center.

None of the helpers are allowed to enter the non-feeding area. There will be a corridor for helpers who have to go to the helper's area, no other crosses at other places are allowed.

With competitors running at high speed, with canoes on their shoulders, with restricted vision it is important for safety that the marshal's instructions are obeyed.


Due to the high number of paddlers, the marshals who are in control of the portage area, will be strict and will only allow you into the feeding area if you are supporting your paddler.

Helpers should not stop suddenly after helping their paddler as there may well be another boat coming behind them and the paddler of this second boat may not see you. Go to the end of the feeding lane and return to the beginning by the third lane provided.

Liquid bags

It is strictly prohibited to throw away liquid bags and other trash in the lake. Make sure to get rid of your trash in the liquid zone in the portage. If this rule is not being followed, you will be given a 30 second penalty.


FIRST AND SECOND LAPS FIRST PORTAGE AT END OF SECOND LAP

Boat Storage

Boats storage will be available at the Event venue on racking and there will be 24-hour surveillance to ensure security from Saturday, August 26. All masters boats will have to be removed from storage no later than Wednesday, August 30 at 1 pm. However, if you need storage for your boat after this time, there will be a special area for Master's boats during the following Championships.

Tents for shade

Master paddlers may use the tents set up in the athlete area. Only access for accredited people.

Training facilities

Training will be available for accredited masters only from Saturday, August 26 at 12pm - 18pm (no life guard) and Sunday August 27 from 9-17 (with life guard) Masters. NO TRAINING ON THE REGATTA COURSE DURING ELITE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS RACES AND DEMOSTRATION RACES.

CEREMONIES

Opening Ceremony

Sunday, August 27 at 17:00 - 17:45 at the Viking Arena. All information for the race is in this document. The Opening Ceremony is our way of welcoming you to Lake Jels and the community of Vejen, Denmark.

Medal Ceremony

The presentation will be done in front of the Grand Stand, behind the portage. All competitors who receive medals must be present 15 minutes before the scheduled time at the medal ceremony tent next to the competition tower/Post Race Boat Control. Noting the order of the awards will be as follows:

Behind them will be three ladies with the medals on cushions.

The event will be announced and the athletes and officials will march on to the prize giving area.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL PADDLERS RECEIVING MEDALS HAVE FULL NATIONAL OR CLUB TRACK SUITS, WITH NO HATS OR SUNGLASSES.

NO MEDAL CEREMONY WHEN LESS THAN 3 FINISHING BOATS.

ALL OTHER MEDALS WILL BE GIVEN AT THE WELCOME CENTRE.

ADEL CERTIFICATION

International Canoe Federation congress has endorsed a proposal to extend compulsory anti-doping education courses to all masters, senior, U23 and junior international athletes and team staff across all canoeing disciplines.

It is important federations and teams understand that these education courses are compulsory for all international athletes and need to be completed before they compete in an international competition. This course gives athletes information about the dangers of doping and the importance of anti-doping controls and promotes positive attitudes to avoiding doping.

For the ones who did the course earlier, it will not be necessary to do the education again. All paddlers who compete in these Championships need an ALPHA certification: "International-Level Athletes Education Program (English)": hpps://adel.wada-ama.org/learn. However, your national Anti-Doping education is also accepted.

IMPORTANT RULES

DISQUALIFICATION FOR UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOUR

10.12.1 - Any athlete who attempts to compete in a race by any other than honourable means or who breaks the racing rules, or who disregards the honourable nature of the racing rules will be penalised or disqualified for the duration of the race concerned.

Failing to follow the correct course

10.12.2 - Should an athlete have failed to follow the correct course of the race (for example missed a turning buoy) the athlete has broken the racing rules will be subject to a penalty:

10.12.2.a - If the Race Umpire believes the athlete has gained a small advantage on other athletes: Time penalty of 15 seconds will be given;

10.12.2.b - If the athlete has gained a major advantage a disqualification (DSQ) will be imposed;

10.12.2.c - Should a buoy be missed as a result of a collision in group racing during a turn this will be investigated and the boat that caused the collision will be penalised or disqualified (DSQ), see article

10.12.3. The athlete who missed the buoy due to collision will not be penalised.

10.12.3 - Collision or damage:

10.12.3.a - Any athlete who is considered by a Course Umpire or Race Official to have been responsible for a collision, or who damages the canoe or kayak or paddle of another athlete or unnecessarily deviates from the direct racing line or deliberately blocks the path of an athlete may be penalized or disqualified;

10.12.3.b - A collision will be considered to be an event where an athlete's boat or paddle touches another athlete's boat or paddle in a way that disadvantages another athlete;

10.12.3.c - If it is considered that other paddlers have only had some minor disadvantages compare to other athletes as a result of the incident the responsible athlete will get a time penalty of 30 seconds;

10.12.3.d - If it is considered that the incident has given other paddlers a major unfair disadvantage the penalty will be disqualification (DSQ).

Boat scrutineering infringement

Should a competitor have completed a race in a kayak or canoe which is shown, upon inspection, not to fulfil the ICF classifications, he or she shall be disqualified from the race in question.

IMPORTANT RULES

Accompanying infringement

10.9.1 - An athlete may not be accompanied along the course or assisted in any way by other canoes/kayaks not entered in the event or by any vessel (e.g., runabout).

Such acts shall entail the disqualification of the competitor/s concerned.

Handling of penalties

Time penalties are decided by the Chief Course Umpire and are not subject to appeal.

Time penalties shall be executed in a designated area at the portage and supervised by a race official or will be added to the competitors finishing time if a time penalty stop is not used in the competition.

Disqualifications are decided by the Competition Committee and are subject to appeal.

Any appeal against a disqualification by the Competition Committee must be made in writing to the Competition Committee within 30 minutes of the end of the relevant race.

If a competitor is observed by an International Official to throw a drink bag into the water, they will receive a 30 second penalty. The decision is to be confirmed by the Chief Course Umpire and cannot be the subject of an appeal.

Penalties must be taken at the Penalty box. If there is any penalty, yellow flag will be raised and number will be displayed on a noticeboard at the start of the portage. Paddler has to take the penalty immediately at the portage.

If the penalty is not taken on the portage then the penalty will be added to the athlete's race time.
